



STUDENT: I tested positive for COVID-19 and am isolating off campus.

FACULTY

Fill out [form reporting](#) case

Decide best way to continue instruction for isolating student

Zoom student in using classroom tech

Record or otherwise post class presentations

Meet with student to develop alternative plan

STUDENT

Student Isolates as directed by Testing & Case (T&C) Coordinator

Student [reports case on form](#), initiating contact tracing

Follow instructions from T&C Coordinator regarding return to class

A student in my course is positive for COVID-19.

What do I do to protect myself and those I come into contact with?

The [CDC](#) considers a number of factors in determining if a “close contact” has occurred, including the type, proximity, and duration of exposure, environmental factors (such as crowding and ventilation), vaccination status, and mask use.
