

General Education Academic Passport Guide – admitted BEFORE Fall 2019

The Academic Passport was created for transfer students from Pennsylvania Community Colleges to help the transition into four-year PASSHE schools. It is available to students with an earned A.A., A.F.A, or A.S. degrees from PA community colleges. Additionally, effective Fall 2018 all A.A.S degrees from CCP and effective Fall 2019 all A.A.S degrees from DCCC are now eligible for Passport. More information can be found:
