ASL Review Cycle

The annual ASL Review follows a 3-year cycle in which all 7 components are reviewed and scored in Year 1 and only the components Results and Action Plans are reviewed and scored in Years 2 and 3. The following table shows the ASL Review cycle year, the academic year and the rubric components reviewed in each.



Action Plans

 \checkmark Action plan provided for all outcomes indicated in rotation schedule.

- ✓ Action plans do either 1 or 2:
 - 1. Identify curricular strengths that contribute to outcome achievement that will be continued, enhanced, etc.
 - 2. Identify targeted action/intervention and timeline to address lack of outcome achievement.
- ✓ Actions plans should identify the time horizon in which the actions will be implemented, e.g., over the next academic year or Spring 2023.

Action Plan Example

While our students are exceeding goals in this area generally, faculty would like to see an improved distribution of rubric scores, i.e., more 4/exemplary scores. Faculty agree that while relevant theory should remain a core component of the curriculum, more instruction and opportunity for student application should be devoted to defining the problem, facilitating stakeholder involvement in agenda-setting, and formulating, implementing, and evaluating policy. These changes will be made in the upcoming academic year.
